**Required Attire, English:** boots with heel, breeches, belt, helmet, English shirt or polo shirt, (shirts must be tucked in), jacket. (Judge can make decision regarding jackets in hot weather

helmet required for all riders under 18 whenever on horse on show grounds

2-minute gate rule will be strictly enforced unless there is a tack change on file with sign-up booth. If you miss your class, class fees are forfeited

All class and rider changes must be made at sign-up booth. Additions to classes will be accepted up to the start of 2 classes before your desired class (i.e. when class #12 starts, class 14 is closed)

If you wish to scratch a class, please inform the sign-up booth. There is no refund for scratched classes. Entries will not be traded for another class

For the safety of all participants, horses out of control may be requested to leave the arena or show grounds

Riders are responsible for entering classes appropriate for age

POINTS ARE BASED ON SAME HORSE/RIDER COMBINATION

RIDER MUST BE PRESENT WHEN HIGH POINT IS ANNOUNCED TO WIN

18 AND UP - QUALIFYING CLASSES: 6,7,11,14,15,18,19,22,24,26 through 30

Lunging will be confined to lunging area at the southeast corner of the parking lot

Warm-up/school horses in the area on the east side of the arena

The parking lot is for vehicles with trailers only. Please park all vehicles without a trailer outside of the parking lot roadside on Excelsior Ave.

Abuse to animals or people will not be tolerated

Events with less than 3 entries may be combined or cancelled: TLRC reserves the right to do so

No refunds for scratched classes

All dogs must be kept on a leash while on TLRC grounds
